## Dubai's Best Spots for High Tea

Afternoon tea might be a quintessentially British pastime, but with a whole host of options rivalling anything the UK has to offer, Dubai has become the go-to destination for tea lovers. Here are six great options for a fix of chai.

### Sahn Eddar Restaurant, Burj al Arab

For over-the-top luxury and pure decadence, the Burj al Arab, which proudly proclaims itself as 'Dubai's only seven-star hotel, is truly without rival. The afternoon tea at the first-floor Sahn Eddar restaurant is an exercise in elegance and indulgence. Split into three servings per day (1pm, 3pm and 5pm), the service is always impeccable, as is the selection of dainty sandwiches, pastries and cakes.

### **Al-Bayt, The Palace Downtown Dubai**
